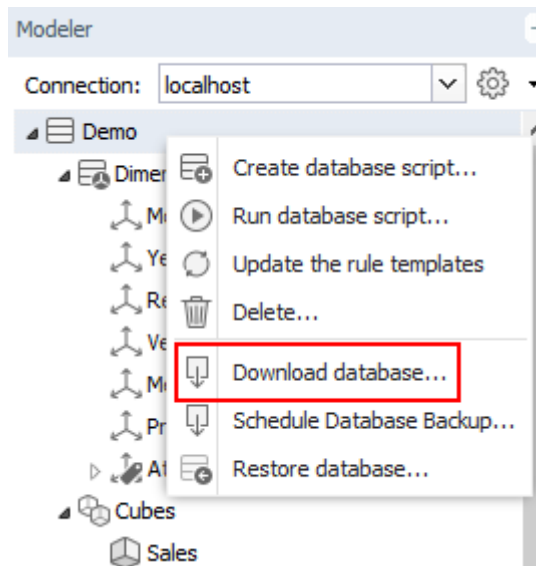



Downloading a Database

You can download a database by right-clicking it in Modeler:



Select **Download database...** A dialog is displayed, prompting you to select the [storage location](#) for the downloaded file.



The following options are available:

- **Local file system** stores the backup file on the local machine. You must enter a name for the file. After clicking **Download...** you will be prompted to either open the file or save it to a location of your choice.
- **Report Designer** stores the backup file within Jedox Web Report Designer. Use the **Browse** button to define the location and the name for the backup file.
- **Server file system** stores the backup file to the default location in the In-Memory DB.

If you download to the local file system or Report Designer, you can set a password to protect the file. Additionally, you can include the system database and archived files. By default, the backup includes CSV files. If you uncheck this option, the database is downloaded with *.bin files.



If you uncheck this option, the backup is created with *.bin files. **Note:** backups created with CSV allow transfer between Linux and Windows.

When you click **Download**, the system creates a backup and allows you to download the database in .zip format.
