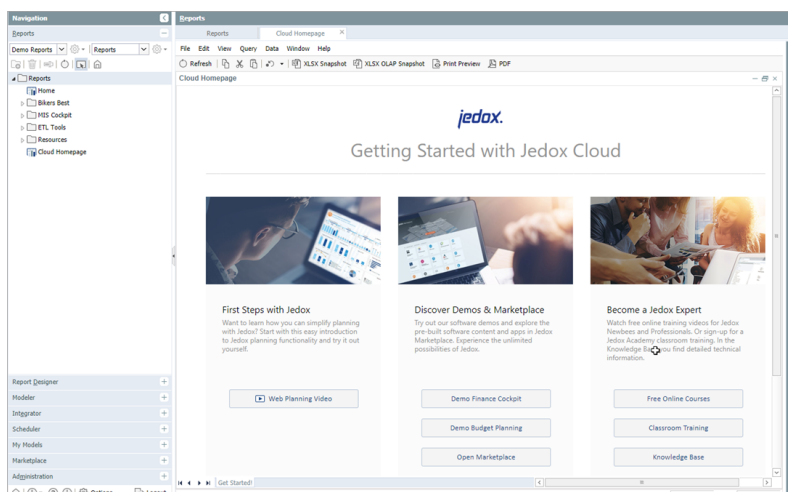

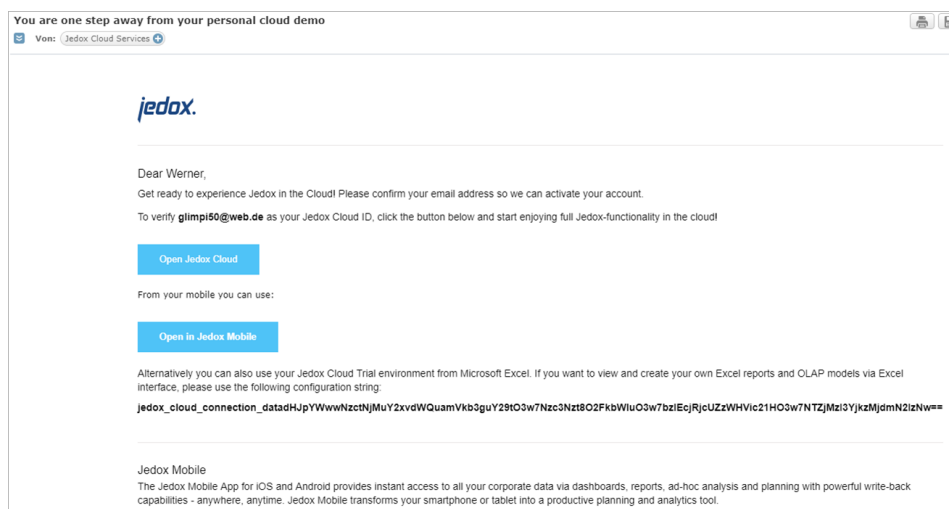

In addition, you will receive following email:




Click **Open Jedox Cloud** in this email to verify your entered email address as your Jedox Cloud ID.

## Using the configuration string in this email

In the email, you receive the configuration string to use Jedox Cloud Trial environment from Microsoft Excel. To do this:

1. Start **Jedox Connection Wizard** and click **Add Connection:**

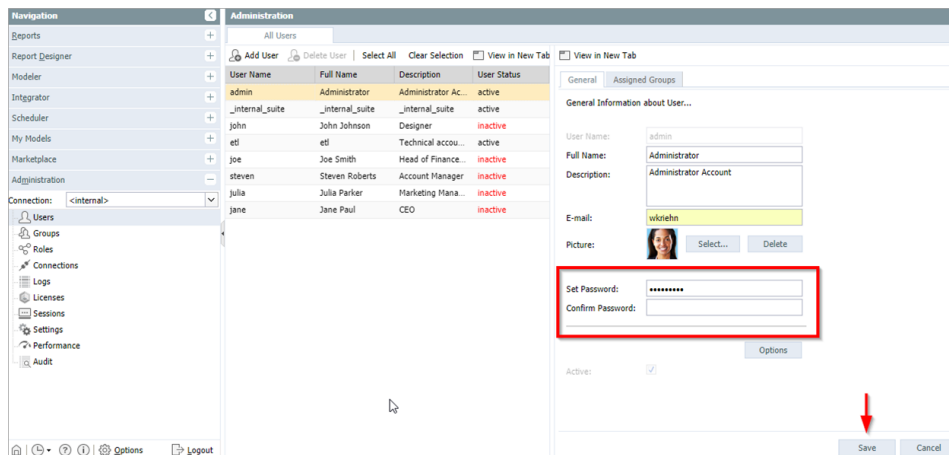

## Changing the password of your Jedox Cloud account

You have administrator rights and therefore you can enter a new

password in Jedox Web > **Administration** without providing the current password:



Select the user **admin** in **Users**, set a new password and save it. You have to use the new password also for the connection of Excel Add-in to Jedox Web. The password delivered with the configuration string will not work afterward.
